

Stolen Horse Polo - Renfrewshire

Polo was stolen from his field sometime between 21.30hrs on the 9th May and 09.30hrs on the 10th May

He is a 16.1hh Thoroughbred light bay gelding aged 7 years - please see photo below.

Please also be aware that there have been a few cases of mane plaiting in Perthshire. These incidents should be reported to the Police as suspicions for fear of it being a way to mark horses for stealing, however, there have never been any horses stolen as a result of plaiting. We do ask people to take any necessary precautions just in case: ie move horse/pony to a different field, review your security ie fencing and gates. Have your horse micro-chipped and freeze-marked, change the times you visit your horse in case your 'coming and goings' have been watched.

Plaitings can also commonly be harmless 'wind plaits' and some people even think 'witch plaits' - but again, normally no harm ever comes to the horse.
